

# Positions: River Rangers & Junior River Rangers

The Woonasquatucket River Watershed Council (WRWC) is seeking individuals with experience or interest in landscaping and maintenance, and strong people skills, to fill both **River Ranger** (18 + years old) and **Junior River Ranger** (16-24 years old) positions. River Rangers & Jr. Rangers work with volunteer groups to maintain the parks and bike path along Woonasquatucket River Greenway. Daily tasks include operating a stand up mower, line trimming, weeding and mulching, brush cutting, litter pick up, watering plants, sweeping, raking, river clean ups, tree pruning, fence repair, graffiti removal, and more (based on age and experience). River Rangers are stewards of the Greenway and are responsible for greeting people in the community and encouraging the appropriate use of this beloved outdoor space.

# **Duties and responsibilities:**

- Maintain the 7-mile Greenway and assist in maintenance of parks near bike path;
- Maintain & operate equipment to a high level, following equipment safety and maintenance procedures (18+);
- Comply with all safety practices and procedures, including use of Personal Protective Equipment;
- Work a non-standard work week (some evenings and weekends as scheduled);
- Manage incoming River Rangers and unskilled Junior River Rangers, based on experience and as assigned (18+);
- Develop and lead volunteer projects.

# Minimum qualifications - Junior River Rangers 16-24 years old

- Be a resident of Providence;
- Able to work outdoors in all weather conditions doing hard manual labor;
- Provide positive personal, academic and/or work references.

### Minimum qualifications - River Rangers 18+ years old:

- High school graduate or equivalent;
- Must be at least 18 y/o and possess and maintain a valid driver's license, with a clean driving record;
- Able to work outdoors in all weather conditions, carry up to 50 lbs. & climb uneven surfaces;
- Provide positive work references.

#### Preferred Qualifications - River Rangers 18+ years old:

- Two years of experience in landscaping, ground & turf management or related field;
- Skill and knowledge with installing & maintaining plants (perennials, shrubs, evergreens, trees) and hardscape;
- Able to read landscape plans, then prepare project tools, materials and team;
- Experience working as a crew leader staff and / or volunteers;
- Skill and knowledge operating & maintaining tools and equipment required for ground and turf maintenance;
- Experience driving large vehicles & towing a large trailer;
- Able to communicate effectively and courteously, both verbally and in writing (Spanish speaking a plus).

**Compensation**: River Rangers: 40 hrs/week, seasonally, starts now, compensation, benefits, pay based on skill;

Jr. River Rangers: 20 hrs/week, 6 weeks, starts July 1 (possibility to continue); pay based on skill.

The Woonasquatucket River Greenway is a 7-mile bike path that follows the river, both on-road and off-road, from Providence to Johnston. The WRWC has worked to restore and create urban parks along the Greenway – Merino Park, Woony Adventure Park, Donigian Park, and Riverside Park. River Rangers work with the Police Department, Providence and Johnston Parks Department, the Providence Housing Authority, local organizations, businesses, churches, recreation centers, and community members to revitalize the parks, maintain the bike path, and educate and empower the watershed community.
